

Certificate Program in Advanced Teaching and Learning

The **Certificate Program in Advanced Teaching and Learning** is a year-long (September 2024 through September 2025) teaching development program that supports the development of graduate students' expertise in teaching and learning. It serves both graduate students seeking excellence in teaching and learning in their future roles as faculty, as well as those who will apply the skills outside of traditional faculty roles.

The Certificate Program in Advanced Teaching and Learning consists of the following elements:

- **Blended Cohort** Meets twice per month on Friday afternoons for two hours per meeting, and includes two hours of online work per month.
- **Practicum** The Certificate Program in Advanced Teaching and Learning requires that you arrange 2-3 one-hour (minimum) practical teaching experiences per term as a guest instructor, in the community, or in industry (total of 6 over the period of 1 year).
- **Mentoring** You will work with a mentor, which will include some classroom observation and some classroom discussion.
- **SoTL** You will engage in a small-scale Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) pilot project based on the work you have done in your practicum.

Please note there is a **one-time program fee of \$500** when you are accepted to the program.

The Program is open to all UBC graduate students who have completed an <u>Instructional Skills Workshop (ISW)</u> and will remain graduate students until September 2025. If you have not completed the ISW, but are interested in the program, please contact <u>ctlt.gcpinfo@ubc.ca</u>


Institute for Global Health: Special Seminar
